AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE TOWN CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING PARKING IN OFF-STREET PARKING FACILITIES OWNED OR OPERATED BY THE TOWN. (2010-12-06/O-6)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Chapel Hill as follows:

Section 1. Section 21-28.2(b) of the Town Code of Ordinances, "Parking in off-street parking facilities owned or operated by the Town is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) No vehicle shall be parked in an off-street parking facility owned or operated by the town except in a marked parking space or area; no vehicle shall be parked without authorization in a space designated as reserved (by a sign at the space or at the entrance to the off-street parking facility) except for the purpose for which the space is reserved. No vehicle shall be parked in a town operated Park and Ride lot except for the purpose of the driver riding Chapel Hill Transit or another public transit provider. A vehicle parked in violation of this subsection may be removed pursuant to procedures in the Chapel Hill Code of Ordinances and may be recovered only upon payment of towing and storage charges; and violations shall be subject to civil penalty as provided in section 21-38 of the Town Code."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective at each Park and Ride lot once signs showing the new regulations at major entrances to that lot have been posted.
